COVID-19 Operating Plan

Effective August 11, 2022

Our dedicated team continues to monitor and follow guidelines issued by local, state, and federal public health agencies. We are committed to working with Event Organizers, with a common goal of healthy and safe events in our facilities.

Event Organizers wishing to hold in-person meetings and events in Phoenix Convention Center & Venues facilities shall adhere to the following COVID-19 safety protocols:

	Requirements for Indoor Gatherings Effective August 11, 2022
COVID Capacity Limitations	No restrictions.
Physical Distancing	CDC guidelines recommend keeping a distance from others to minimize exposure to the virus.
Temperature / Health Screenings	Temperature and health screenings will be at the discretion of the Event Organizer.
Face Coverings	CDC guidelines recommend well-fitting face coverings in public indoor spaces when COVID-19 community levels are high. People who are at high risk should also wear a mask when their communities are at the medium level, according to guidelines.
Proof of Vaccination / COVID Testing	Proof of vaccination, or a recent negative COVID-19 test, may be required for event attendees and/or staff at the discretion of the Event Organizer.
