| COVID Capacity Limitations | No restrictions. |
| Physical Distancing | CDC guidelines recommend keeping a distance from others to minimize exposure to the virus. |
| Temperature / Health Screenings | Temperature and health screenings will be at the discretion of the Event Organizer. |
| Face Coverings | CDC guidelines recommend well-fitting face coverings in public indoor spaces when COVID-19 community levels are high. People who are at high risk should also wear a mask when their communities are at the medium level, according to guidelines. |
| Proof of Vaccination / COVID Testing | Proof of vaccination, or a recent negative COVID-19 test, may be required for event attendees and/or staff at the discretion of the Event Organizer. |
